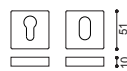
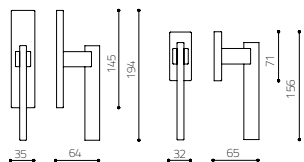

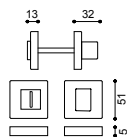
C205S - fixed window slider

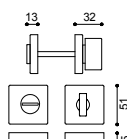

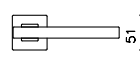

Franco Sargiani

Modena, 1940



An architect who graduated from the Milan Polytechnic, Sargiani specialised in several studios in England, Sweden, Finland and Denmark. After returning to Italy, he opened a studio and worked as an architect, building private homes, residential buildings, office buildings, and industrial complexes.

He designed several products with Eija Helander, including Alessi's famed Program 8 in 1975. This modular system revolutionised tableware design and is still being manufactured.

Several of Sargiani's objects are found in the permanent collections of Milan, San Paolo, Berlin, Solingen and Dusseldorf museums.
